By the mid-1990s, AutoCAD was considered the dominant CAD program in the United States. AutoCAD LT, a low-cost version of AutoCAD, was introduced in 1995. From its beginning, Autodesk rebranded AutoCAD as "AutoCAD for all" to broaden the market. In 1995, Autodesk introduced AutoCAD LT, a low-cost AutoCAD that could be used for such applications as architectural design, sheet metal forming, technical drawing, house drafting, blueprints and mechanical drawings. Since then, AutoCAD LT has been the most popular AutoCAD program. History AutoCAD was the first commercial CAD program. Although the first CAD programs were developed by the United States military, the first commercially successful CAD programs were developed in the 1960s, and were based on the vector graphics approach that was popular at the time. In the late 1970s, when personal computers became available for home use, CAD programs started being developed for the desktop. These programs were generally based on the graphic approach. The first CAD program to be sold to the general public was Larry Johnson's Visible Thinking, a vector graphics program, which was released in 1981 for the Apple II personal computer. Visible Thinking had been developed for the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation. In the early 1980s, Harry Schmitt, who had left Visible Thinking to form a new company, introduced VectorWorks, a vector graphics CAD program that was designed to run on IBM-compatible personal computers. VectorWorks was the first successful CAD program for the personal computer. VectorWorks for the Apple Macintosh and AutoCAD followed. In 1983, Cadsoft introduced Microsoft's first commercial CAD program, SolidWorks, a vector graphics program for the Microsoft DOS. In 1984, AgisSoft released AutoCAD, its first vector-based AutoCAD program. AutoCAD 1.0 ran on an early microcomputer, the CDC 6500, and was the first CAD program to run on a desktop computer. AutoCAD 1.0 was soon superseded by AutoCAD 2.0, which had a vector-based user interface, but required programming skills to implement the program. At the time, AutoCAD was considered by many to be the most powerful CAD program available, and it had a large professional following. AutoCAD 2.0 became the standard for CAD for more than a decade.
