Q: How would life on earth have been if there were no animal and plant life? We (humans) have been feeding on plants for a million years or so (but don't let this fool you, most of our ancestors were carnivorous for the first 100,000 years of our existence). Going back even further, we can trace our evolutionary development back to the apes who were eating leaves and other plants to stay alive. As to the plants, they

---

survived by using suns energy as heat via photosynthesis, or by eating bacteria and small insects. If there would be no animals, there might be bacteria and arthropods. If that were so, mightily small plants would still be able to live. A: If you take a look at the factors needed for the development of animals, they are: Water Temperature Mechanical forces Chemical signals Now, if you take a look at plants, they only need chemical signals. There is no requirement for temperature, mechanical forces or water. In other words, with the exception of photosynthesis (which is not a force), plants can function with

---

only the chemical part of biology, and ignore all the other three. If you take an extreme example, if you take a planet that is only made up of chemical compounds, there will be a very small probability that anything else will develop. That's the reason why there are no animals in a vacuum, only small-scale plants (think bacteria). If you want something bigger, the first thing you need is a frame for the frame of biological self-reproduction. If you take a look at rocks,

proteins. Several monoclonal antibodies to M13 bacteriophage coat proteins were obtained using three different antigen-antibody systems. They can be divided into two distinct groups: 1) those which recognise the long N-terminal portion of the p2 coat protein and 2) those which recognise the N-terminal region of the p7 coat protein. Some of the anti-p2 mAb are directed against the capsid and others are directed against the tail. Several can be directed against the same amino acid sequence, i.e., the p2 antigenic site. Most of the anti-p2 mAb bind at the same site as p2 but three antibodies appear to be directed against a second site on

the surface of the coat. In contrast, anti-p7 antibodies are directed against the N-terminal part of the tail. Some of the monoclonal antibodies against p7 are directed against the sequence common to the three different subunits of the tail.
